FewClix (for Notes) – What's New

What's New in 3.1:

1. Configurable limits for Dropdown and Search results

Users can now modify the limits for both "Dropdown Lists" and "Search Results" through the "Preferences" (⚙️) menu. Administrators can also modify these limits during enterprise deployment via the Notes.INI file.

What's New in 3.0:

1. Support for Windows 10

FewClix for Notes 3.0 supports Windows 10 64-bit (x64) and Windows 10 32-bit (x86).

2. Enhanced Accuracy

For searches that involve Sender, Subject, Message Content, Attachment Name and Attachment Content, FewClix for Notes 3.0 delivers more accurate and targeted results than earlier versions. For example, in earlier versions, a search for "Jack" will also display results for "Jac", "Jack" and "Jak". This is no longer the case in FewClix for Notes 3.0.

3. Enhanced Performance

FewClix for Notes 3.0 uses an enhanced search engine which provides tighter integration with the IBM Notes Client resulting in faster searches and improvement in performance.

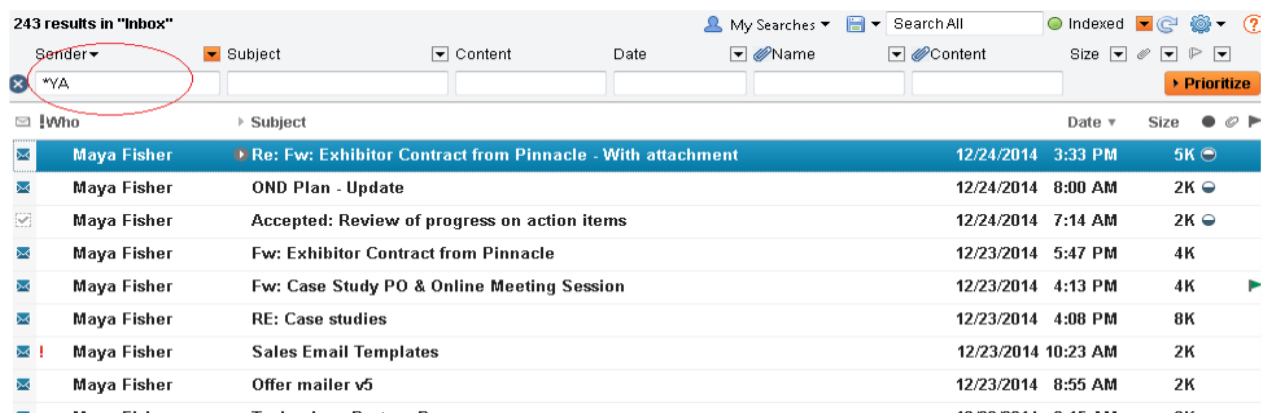
4. Lower Resource Utilization

The file size of the FewClix index is significantly smaller than in previous versions, resulting in lower resource utilization and enhanced performance.

5. Wild Card Search

FewClix for Notes 3.0 supports wild card searches using the characters ? and *.

- A search for **accept??** in Message Content will include results with the words "Accept" and "Accepted, but not "Accepting".
- The * wild card character can be used to find messages using strings that contain parts of words that a word does not begin with. For example, a search for ***ya** in "Sender" will display results for **Maya** as shown in the image:



6. Comprehensive support for “alphanumeric” text

Earlier versions had limited support for searches involving “alpha numeric” text, displaying results only when the alphanumeric text being searched was present either at the beginning or at the end of a sentence. FewClix for Notes 3.0 provides support for such searches irrespective of the position of the alphanumeric text.
