Installation Process

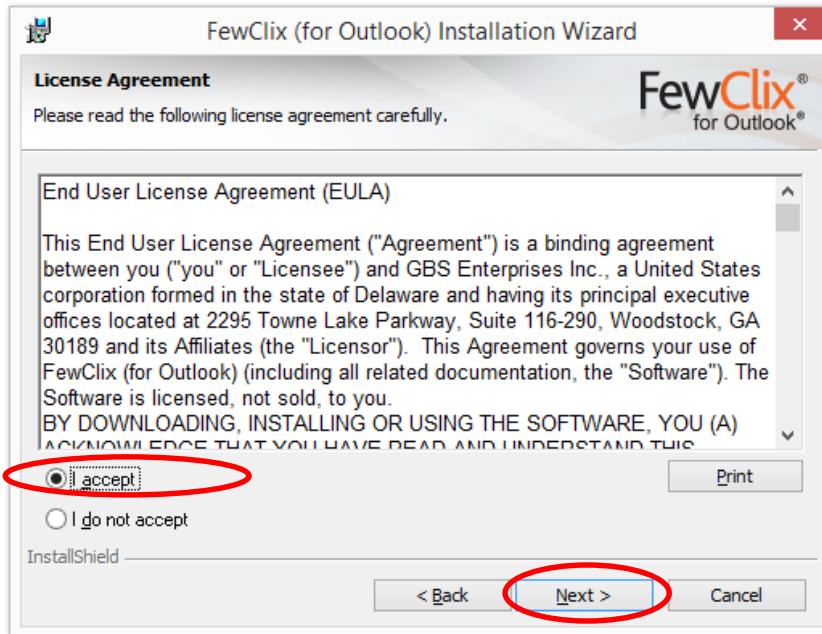
Step 1:

- Double-click the FewClix file (**FewClix for Outlook_x-y-z.exe**)
- Select "**Next**" to view and accept the License Agreement



Step 2:

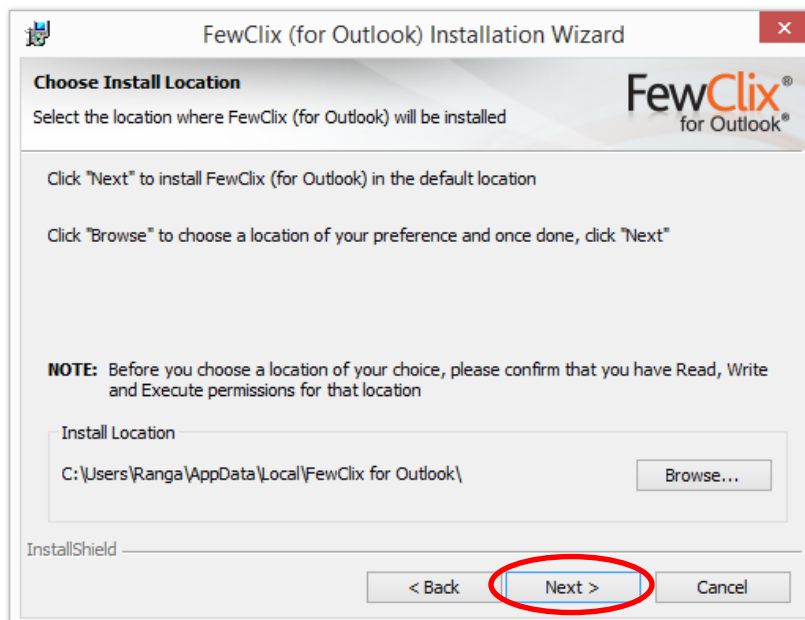
- In the License Agreement screen, select **“I accept the terms of the license agreement”** and click **“Next”**



Step 3:

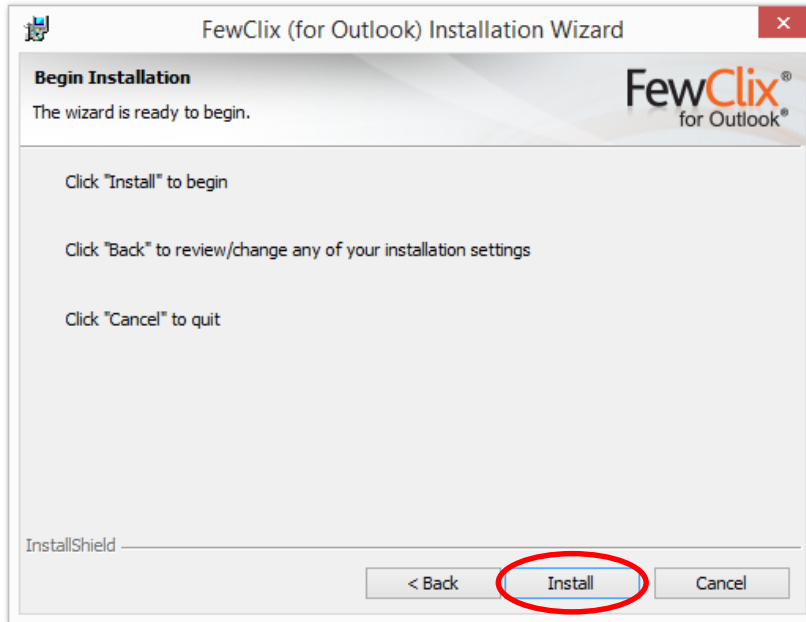
The plugin is installed by default in the “AppData” folder, for example, C:\Users\...\AppData\Local\FewClix for Outlook\

- To install FewClix in a different location, please select **“Browse”** and choose a folder, else, click **“Next”**

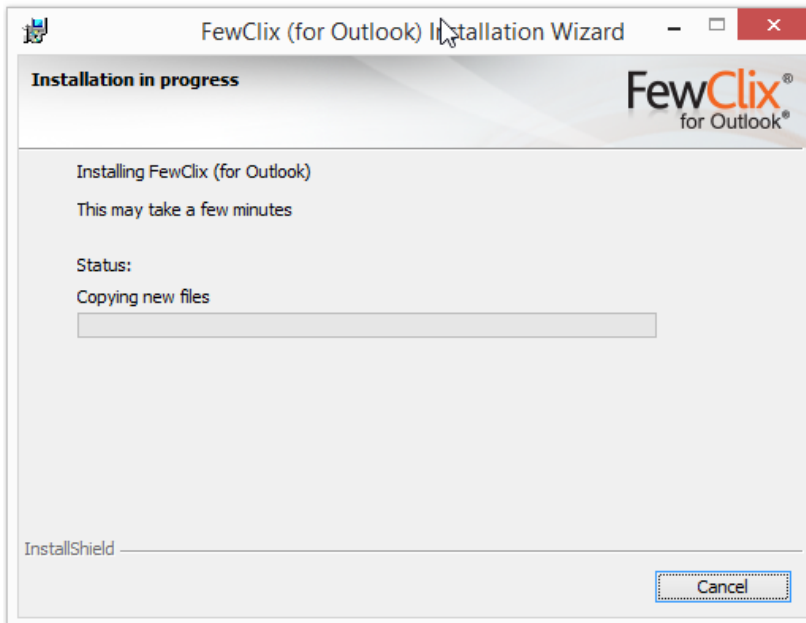


Step 4:

Please click "Install"

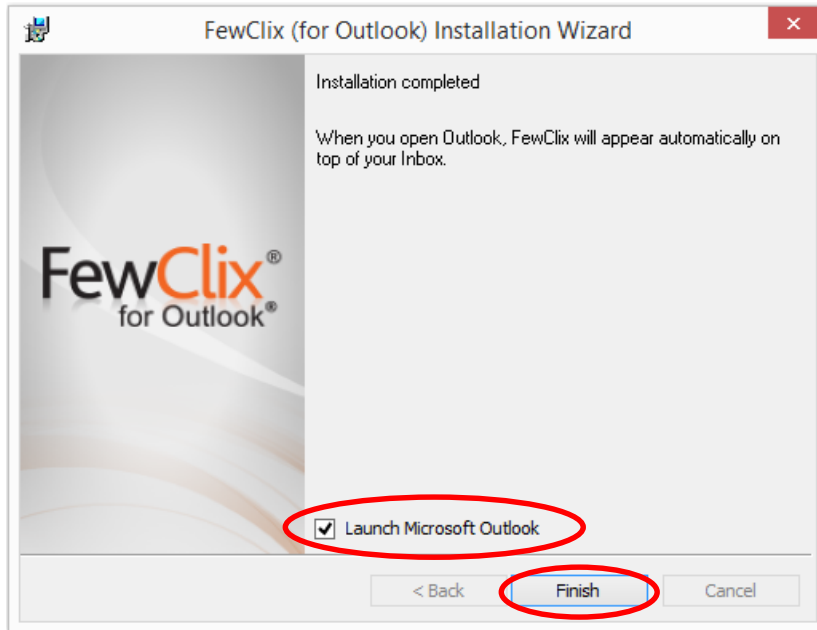


Installation begins...

Please click “**Finish**”.



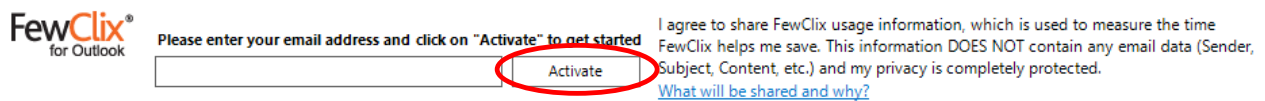
Step 6:

Step 7:

Please ensure that you have a working internet connection before you begin.

Enter your email address and click “**Activate**” to activate your FewClix subscription.
