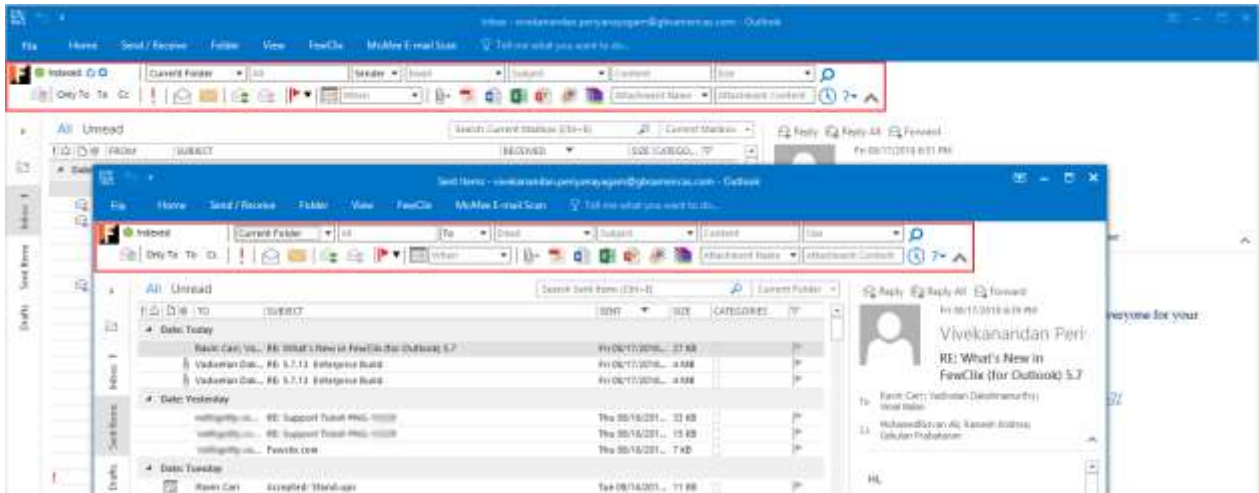
What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.8?

- Performance improvement during initial indexing of Online Exchange accounts
- Fix for FewClix UI displacement in Outlook 2016 Version 1808
- Fix for CPU spike during indexing in some Windows 8.1 environments

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.7?

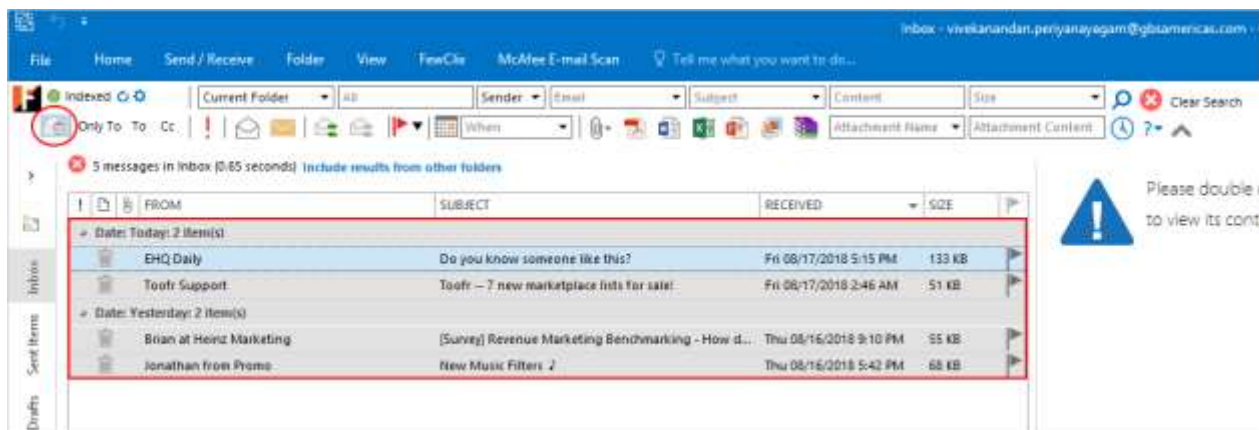
- Support for FewClix in multiple Outlook windows

FewClix users can now access and use FewClix in multiple Outlook windows (both mail and calendar)



- FewClix now keeps "deleted emails"

FewClix keeps and, on request, shows deleted emails to users. We have also included a new "Deleted Emails" filter to help users access these emails with a single click. Since these emails are not present in Outlook anymore, we have also designed a simple text preview to help users see a plain text view of deleted messages



- **Performance improvement during initial indexing of Online Accounts and Online Archives**

Users with Online Accounts or Online Archives might have experienced decreased Outlook performance during the first few minutes of initial indexing. This issue is resolved in FewClix 5.7.

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.6?

- **New "Type ahead search" for Email, Subject, Attachment Name fields**

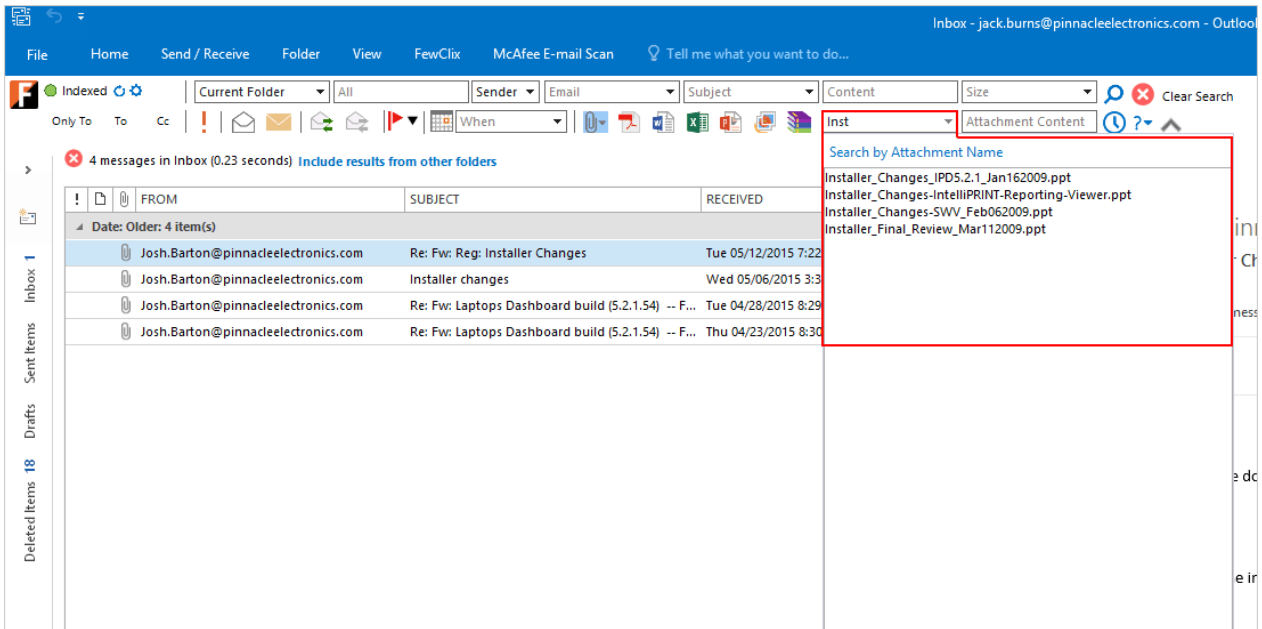

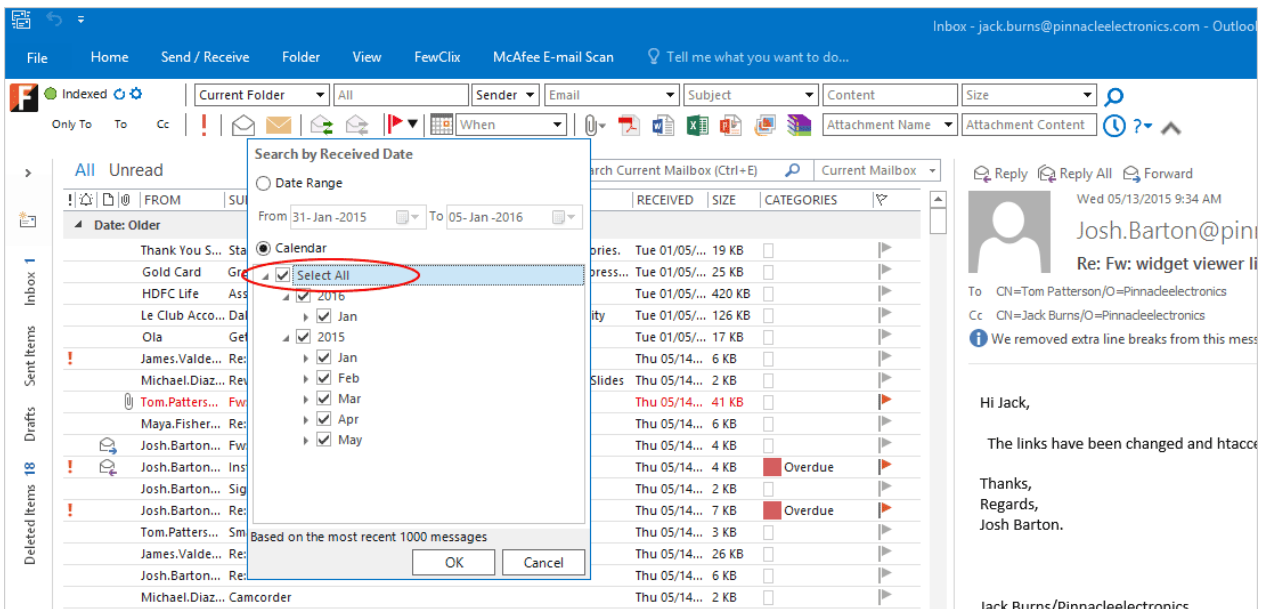

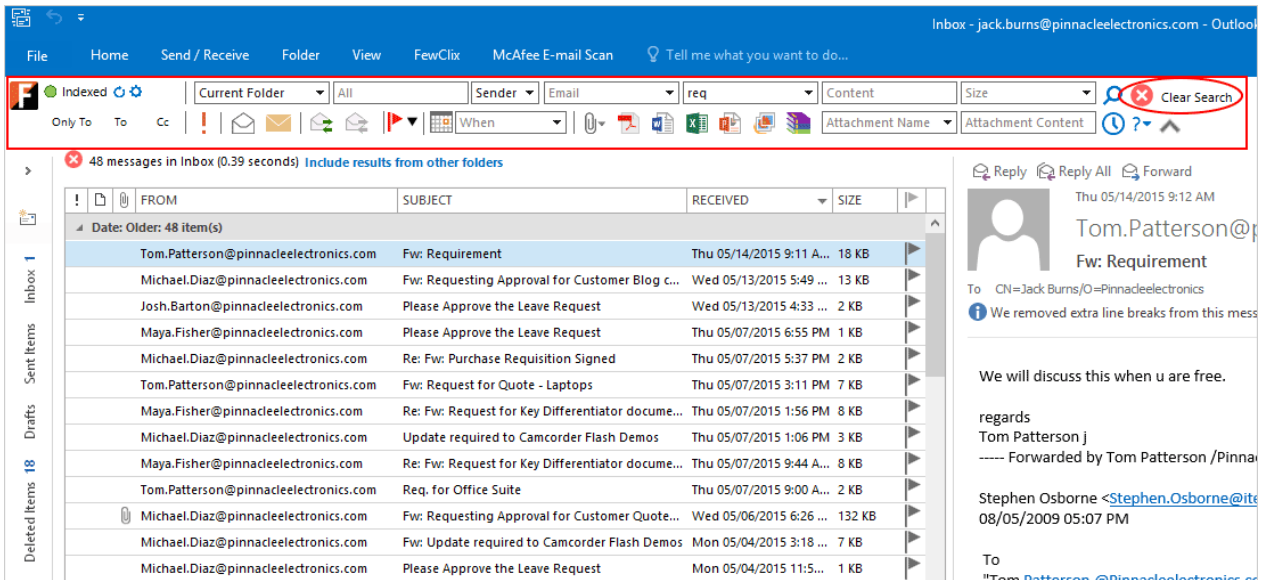

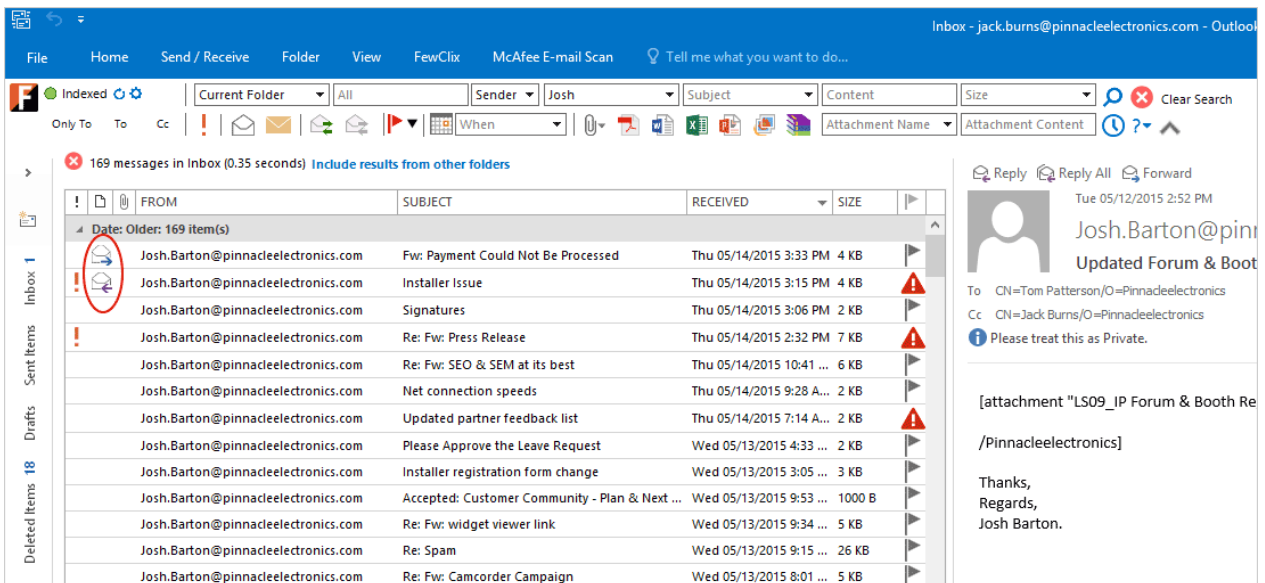
- New "Select / Unselect All" option for the "Search by Date" field

 - The "indexing Options" window has been optimized to provide a better user experience, where users don't have to wait for folders to load any more
 - Consequently, the option to select Folders and Sub-Folders for indexing has been deprecated

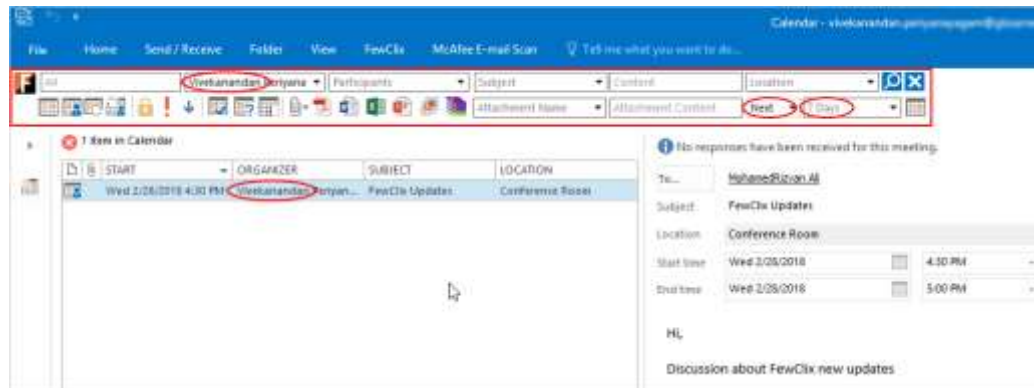
What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.5?

- **Calendar Search**

The new FewClix (for Outlook) 5.5 supports full functionality calendar search and organization.

You can now find any meeting or appointment in seconds using the following options:

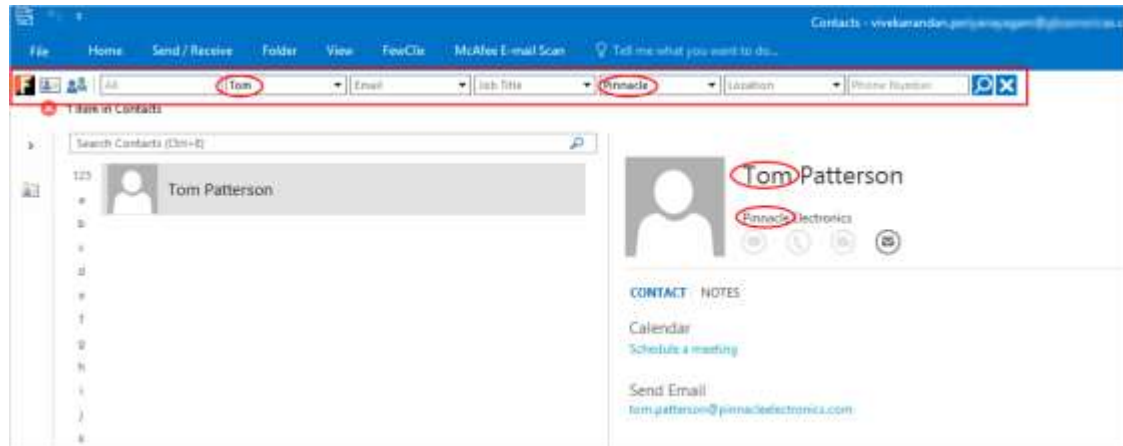
- Organizer
- Participants
- Subject
- Content
- Date
- Location
- Attachment name / Attachment type / Attachment content
- Meetings / Appointments in the "Last n" or "Next n" days
- Meetings by status - Accepted / Tentative / Not Responded



- **Contacts Search**

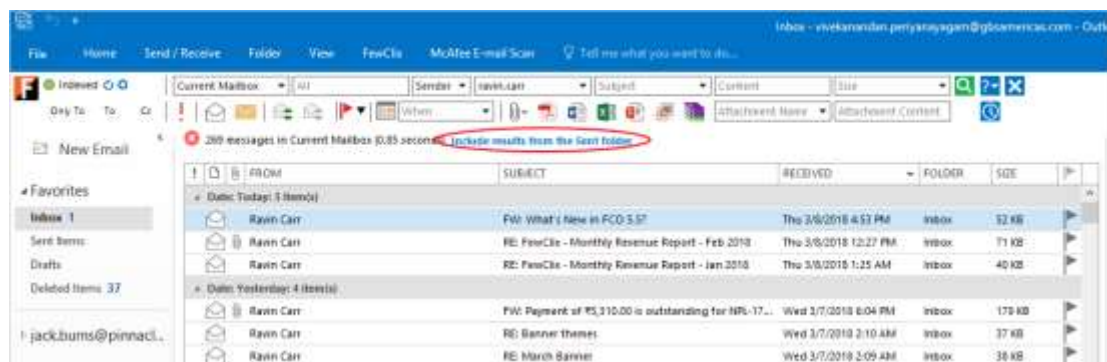
You can find any contact in seconds using the following search options:

- Type (Individual or Group contacts)
- Name
- Email
- Job title
- Company
- Location
- Phone



- **Option to Include results from "Sent Items"**

- While searching for emails using the "Sender" option in your Inbox or in a folder other than "Sent Items", you can now include results from your "Sent Items" folder at the click of a button



- **"View Activity Dashboard" button updates FewClix activity information**

- The "View Activity Dashboard" button, also automatically updates your FewClix activity information so that you see live and real-time data

- **Bug fixes**

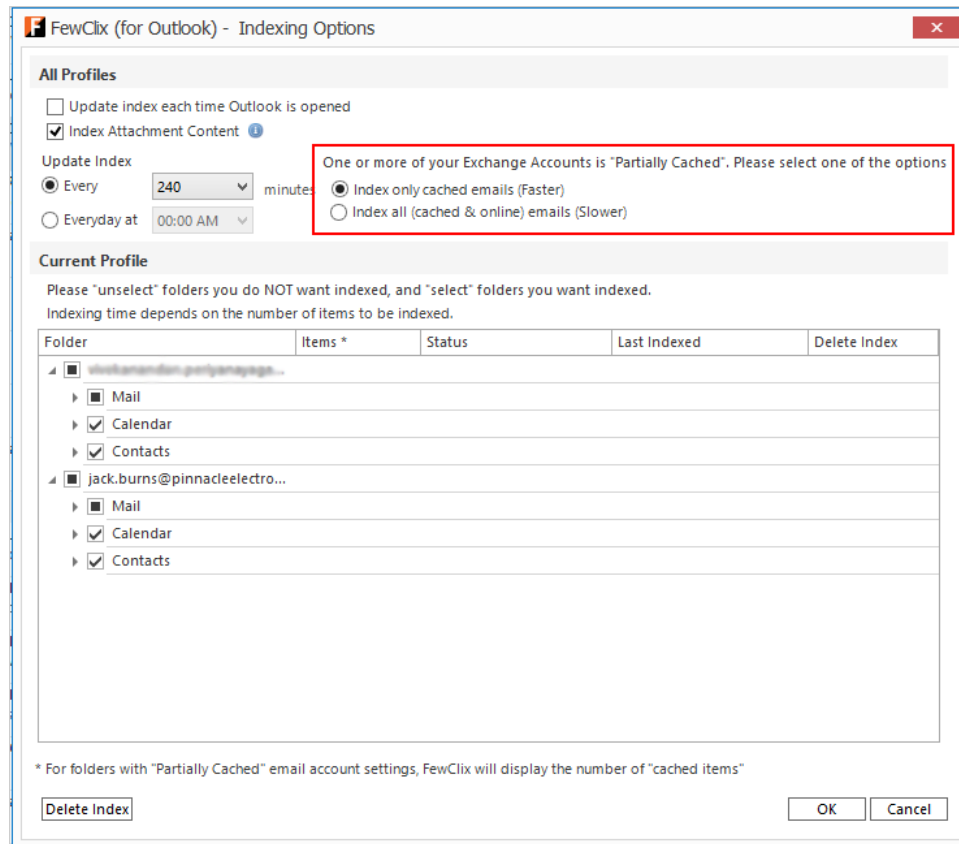
- Fix for "Date Filters" not working for users whose time zone setting is "UTC -"
- Fix for the update interval resetting to 00:00 hours for users using the "Everyday at" Scheduled Index Update setting
- Fix for the intermittent occurrence of the "FCIndexing" process exiting without closing the Outlook Data file

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.3?

- **Search**
 - Support for domain and full email address searches when the email field displays only the sender's or recipient's "First Name + Last Name"
- **User Interface**
 - Enhancements in "Move To" and "Copy To" operations

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.2?

- **Performance improvements**
 - During Outlook launch, close and folder switches.
- **Indexing**
 - Faster initial indexing for "Cached" Exchange accounts
 - Users with "Partially Cached" Exchange accounts can now choose to either index "cached items" only (partial search coverage, but superfast indexing) OR index both "cached items" and "online items" (full coverage, but slower indexing)



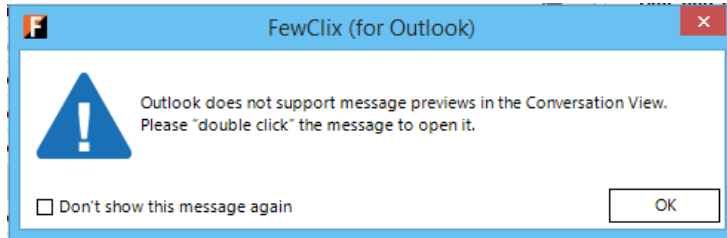
User Interface

- Larger icons for better scalability at all display resolutions



Search

- Minimum search string length changed from “three” characters to “two” characters
- Option to disable pop-up alerts while using Outlook's “Conversation View”



Bugs fixed

- UI issues while scaling fonts and images to display settings higher than 150%
- No search results and empty pull down list during search (inconsistently)
- After being closed manually, FewClix is auto-enabled during folder switches

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.1?

New, slimmer and scalable User Interface *

- The new FewClix 5.1 user interface reduces the amount of real estate occupied inside the Outlook client by over 67%! This gives you more real estate for emails.



- FewClix 5.1 supports new high resolution displays and Windows 10 Display Settings of up to 300% scaling

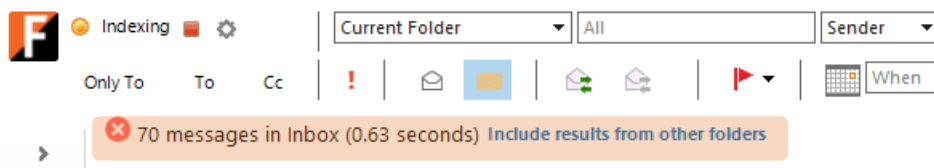


User-defined defaults for which folders to include results from

- Users can now specify the defaults for search results (“Current Folder”, “Current Mailbox”, “All Mailboxes”) and which folders to apply these to (Inbox / All Folders) via FewClix’ “Options”

- **Search across folders with a single click**

- For searches performed in the “Current Folder”, FewClix gives users the option to display results from all folders (“Current Mailbox”) via a single click



- **Important fixes for issues in FewClix 5.0 Beta**

- Outlook freezing / accessibility issues
- FREE Personal Edition subscription not being activated after expiry of the 7-day access to FewClix PRO+

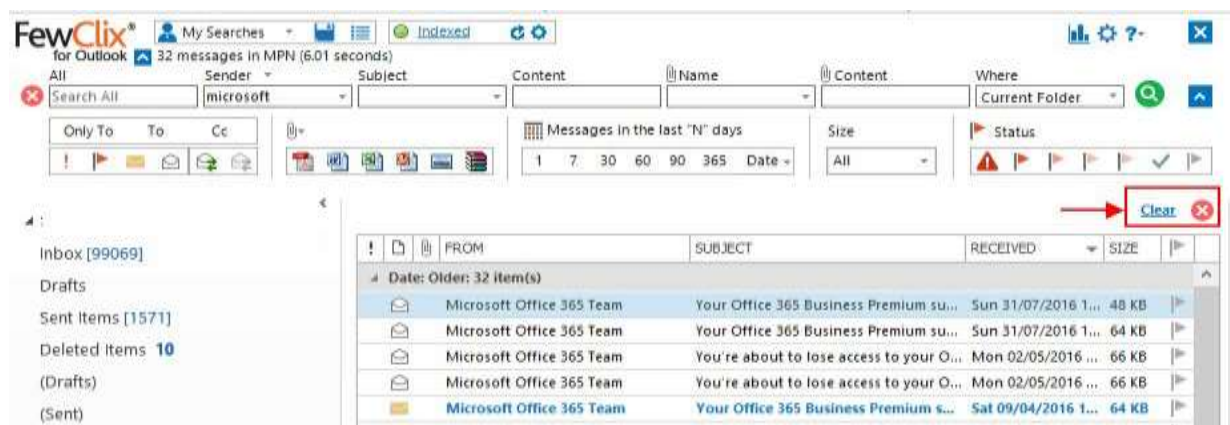
* Due to the new UI, the following features are temporarily unavailable in FewClix 5.1 – Calendar Search, Contact Search, My Searches

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 5.0 Beta?

- **“Zero” impact on Outlook performance**
 - The new and re-architected FewClix 5.0 is designed to do all of its heavy lifting without impacting Outlook’s performance. FewClix now runs as an independent process, without sacrificing the “fully integrated” FewClix user experience.
- **Support for Outlook’s “Conversation View”**
 - FewClix 5.0 supports searches when Outlook’s “Show As Conversations” is enabled (IMPORTANT: Preview for search results is not supported as yet)
- **Improved search coverage**
 - FewClix searches items such as meeting responses, delivery reports, read reports, automated server triggered responses, etc.
 - FewClix searches mail items in the "root" folder of an Outlook Store
- **Improved search results presentation for searches across “All Mailboxes”**
 - A new “Outlook Data File” column has been included in the FewClix search results grid when FewClix searches across “All Mailboxes”
- **Better match with Outlook’s native search experience**
 - Default location for searches is now “Current Mailbox” instead of “Current Folder”

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 4.7

- **Improved performance**
 - Switching between folders is faster
 - Composing emails is faster
- **Usability enhancements**
 - New “Clear” option is now conveniently positioned above and to the right of FewClix search results



- **Deprecated Feature**
 - The progress bar during indexing has been deprecated to improve FewClix performance during indexing.

What's New in FewClix (for Outlook) 4.5

- **Improved indexing performance**
 - Indexing is 14% faster when compared with FewClix 4.0
 - Improvements in Outlook performance during indexing
- **Improved search performance**
 - Search is 19% faster when compared with FewClix 4.0
